School Led Tutoring / Recovery Premium Funding 2022-2023

What is School Led Tutoring Grant?

Under School-Led Tutoring, all eligible state-funded schools are given a ring-fenced grant to fund locally sourced tutoring provision for disadvantaged pupils. This could include using existing staff such as teachers and teaching assistants or external tutoring resources such as private tutors or returning teachers. Funding is allocated for pupils, in Year 1 to 11, eligible for pupil premium.

Our school-led tutoring grant for 22-23 is £486.00.

Our recovery premium grant for 22-23 is £1500.00.

What is Recovery Premium?

Children and young people across the country have experienced unprecedented disruption to their education as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19). We know that we have the professional knowledge and expertise in the school and wider education system to ensure that children and young people recover and get back on track.

Although all children have had their education disrupted by the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, we know that it is likely that disadvantaged and vulnerable groups will have been affected most. The National Tutoring programme and recovery premium funding to schools eligibility:

- pupils who are eligible for free school meals (FSM)
- pupils who have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years
- children looked after by local authorities and referred to as looked-after children (LAC)
- post looked-after children (post-LAC)

School Led Tutoring grant: £486.00

Recovery premium grant £1500.00

1.	Head of School has identified disadvantaged and vulnerable pupils and prioritised intervention groups to address any gaps in their learning and taught/re-taught so that pupils are able to access the next stage of their learning
2.	Specialist TA staff to deliver intervention lessons (targeted support)
3.	Children with an EHCP receive support with their individual intervention plan to meet their needs
4.	CPD time for support and mentoring for teaching and support staff
